EKG course description:

This course is designed to train students to set up and run a 12 lead EKG, and Treadmill with the assistance of a physician, and attach a Holter monitor. Instruction is provided in the anatomy and physiology of the heart and terminology, common to the cardiovascular system. Interpretation of EKG's includes heart rate, basic rhythm strips, and the identification of rhythm abnormalities. Students are trained to recognize changes in EKG's heart blocks, and emergency situations that require immediate action. Hands-on training is an integral part of this training.

- Students will be concurrently enrolled in Medical Terminology as well.
- One semester course worth 10 credits, externship upon completion of the course.
